Register for 4th Annual Youth Leadership Conference

USPAK foundation will hold its 4th Annual Youth Leadership Conference “Shaping Your Future” from **June 22nd to 25th 2013 (revised dates)** at American University, Washington DC. The conference is suited for high school and college students.

In a campus setting, students will participate in tutorials, workshops, and get hands-on training to acquire networking, time management, resume writing, public speaking and interviewing skills during the four days of the conference. Additionally, there will be presentations by Obama Administration Senior Officials. Career guidance workshops, college admissions, career. An interfaith community service project has also been added to this year leadership conference. Students will spend a full day learning public policy advocacy skills, and will hold individual meetings with US Senators and Congressmen at US Capitol to discuss issues important to the students.

Advance skill development modules are planned for returning students who have attended previous conferences. Separate panel discussion sessions are planned for parents attending the conference.

Registration deadline: June 9th 2013, registration is absolutely required for all conference participants, students, non-students, and parents.

Registration Fee:

Registration fee includes all meals during conference, conference material, giveaways, and transportation for organized tours and visits to Government offices in Washington DC.

- A subsidized rate of **\$175** per student for students not requiring any overnight accommodation.

For students requiring dormitory rooms at American University for the duration of the Conference:

- **\$400** per person includes all above items and dormitory room (**2 students per room**) for 3 nights at American University.
- **\$475** per person includes all above items and dormitory room (**1 student per room**) for 3 nights at American University.

State Department is now accepting applications for the [U.S. Department of State 2014 Spring Student Internship Program \(unpaid\)](#). **Please note that the deadline to submit completed applications is July 1, 2013.**

This program offers U.S. citizen undergraduate and graduate students the opportunity to participate in **10-week, unpaid internships** that provide intensive educational and professional experience within the environment of America's principle foreign affairs agency.

The unpaid internships are available at many of the over 265 U.S. embassies, consulates and missions to international organizations around the world, as well as at the Department of State in Washington, D.C. and other locations throughout the U.S. Participants gain first-hand, hands-on experience, and learn the realities of working in – and with – Foreign and Civil Service professionals who are at the forefront of America's diplomatic efforts.

As an unpaid intern, you may have the opportunity to:

- Participate in meetings with senior level U.S. government or foreign government officials;
- Draft, edit, or contribute to cables, reports, communications, talking points, or other materials used by policy makers in furthering U.S. foreign policy objectives;
- Help organize and support events, including international and/or multi-lateral meetings and conferences on critical global issues;
- Contribute to the management and administration of the Department of State and America's foreign policy; and
- Engage directly with U.S. or foreign audiences to promote U.S. foreign policy and improve understanding of U.S. culture and society.
